There is no "battle"

There is not a word said about the Lord God's army. Why should almighty God need an army?

There is no such place as Har-Megedon. Har: City of; and Megedon: Mountain of Megiddo.

The name is symbolic. It signifies a conflict, a spiritual conflict in a mortal human..

Har-Megedon... is the way the word appears in the ASV; and it seems to be associated with the plain of Esdraelon in Israel.

There Israel achieved some of her greatest victories and suffered some serious defeats.

It may not, therefore, be associated with either victory or defect. Perhaps it suggests "the place of decision." That place, of course, is in the hearts of all people. (Coffman)
